

How to separate and dispose of household waste

Burnable garbage (combustibles)

Item that are too large to fit in one designated garbage bag should be placed in bulky garbage.

Non-Burnable garbage (Non-Combustible)

Items that are too large to fit in one designated garbage bag should be classified as bulky garbage.

Let's Work on Reducing Waste and Promoting Reuse and Recycling!

Recycling(Recyclables)

Newspapers, leaflets, magazines (including confectionary boxes, etc), books, Paper bag, cardboard Wrap each item firmly in a cross with a string. Avoid rainy days as much as possible and put it out for the next collection.	Food and beverage bottles Wash clean dry and serve.	Drink, liquor bottles 720ml bottles, 1.8L bottles and beerbottles will you pick it up at the store or please send it to the local group collection.
Beverage cans(juice cans, beer cans, etc.) Food cans(canned foods, confectionary cans, Nori cans, etc) Do not cut it please. Be sure to remove the cap, Remove the contents and be sure to rinse lightly,remove the label.

Recycling of used small household appliances

Collection method Please put the small household appliances that correspond to the following collection items(size 15cm x 25cm or less please put things)in the collection boxes installed in 9 public facilities.

Attention

- Batteries and car batteries cannot be collected. Please remove it before taking it out.
- For items that contain personal information, please reduce the data in advance before putting it out.
- Of the small rechargeable batteries (such as lithium-ion batteries), those with the following recycling marks should be removed and sent to a collection partner store.

Reuse of sake bottles

Collected items: 1.8L bottles, 720ml bottles
※ Beer bottles, juice bottles, etc. are not eligible.

Collection place:

- Town hall building (in front of the entrance of the New building) • Central community center (in front of the entrance of the Judo/Kendo Dojo) • District community center (Toyooka, Kawasaki, Ooga)
- Hearth and Welfare Center ※We also carry out collective collection at dealers and in the region.

 (Request)

- Wash the inside of the bottle thoroughly, dry it, and then serve.
- Please put out the broken bottle on the day of garbage that does not burn.
- Please put only the bottle in the container and take the bag home.
- Please do not put it out with the contents left.

Recycling of Waste Cooking Oil

Oil that can be recovered: Used tempura oil. However, it is limited to plant-based products Example) salad oil, canola oil, sesame oil, olive oil

Collection place:

- Town hall building (in front of the New building) • Central community center (in front of the Judo/Kendo Dojo) • District community center (Toyooka, Kawasaki, Ooga) • Health and Welfare Center

How to serve: Remove the solids, let it cool, put it in a plastic bottle, close the lid tightly, and put it in the box at the collection place.

Remove solids. → After cooling the oil, put it in a plastic bottle. → Tighten the lid of the plastic bottle tightly.

PC recycling

① Apply to the manufacturer, etc
PCs and monitors are collected and recycled by manufacturers. Please check the manufacture of the PC to be discarded and apply for collection from the homepage or dedicated dial. For PCs that do not have a manufactures to collect, such as home-built PCs and PCs of bankrupt manufactures, please apply using the website (<https://www.pc3r.jp/>) of "PC 3R Promotion Association" or dedicated dial (Tel 03-5282-7686)

② Apply to Renet Japan Recycle Co., Ltd. (Hiji town Partnership Operator)

Recycling Fee
The "recycling fee" (collection and recycling fee) is a burden on the person who disposed of it.
Computers with this mark do not require a recycling fee because the recycling fee (collection and recycling fee) is paid at the time of purchase.

Fire extinguisher recycling

The fire extinguisher manufacturer is recycling (paid) the fire extinguisher. Please contact The fire extinguisher store that collect the waste fire extinguisher and the detail of the recycling system 「Fire Extinguisher Recycling Promotion Center (tel 03-5829-6773)」

Subsidy for installation of household garbage disposal container.

In order to promote the reduction of garbage discharged from households, we provide subsidies for the purchase of garbage disposal containers.

Subsidized person	Individuals who have an address in the town and currently residing in the town (Those who have paid the town tax in full)
Subsidy amount	1/2 of the purchase price (Rounded down to the nearest 100yen) (1) Electric type up to 25,000 yen (2) Non-electric type up to 2,000 yen However, as soon as the budget runs out, the reception will be closed.
Required documents	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Receipt (The date of purchase, the store of purchase, the purchase price, and the name of the applicant are listed) A copy of the transfer account, identity verification documents, and insurance card A photo that shows that it is installed
other	Applicants must submit their application within 3 months from the date of purchase.

Oversized garbage

How to dispose

- Apply in advance online or by phone or at the counter Up to 3 items at one time.
- On-line (24-hour reception (excluding maintenance periods))
 - Online applications are accepted until 24:00 on each application deadline.
 - We may contact you to confirm the contents on your application, but if we cannot contact you and confirm it, your application will be invalidated.

Bulky Waste Disposal Stickers

- Fee: 400 yen per sticker (tax included)
- Where to purchase bulky waste disposal stickers: Town Hall or Stores authorized by the town that sell designated garbage bags
- How to stick the Sticker
 - Write a collection date and your name on the purchased sticker, and stick it on a clearly visible part of the item.
 - If it is hard to stick the sticker directly, make a hole in the sticker, thread a string through it, and tie it securely to the item.

Fee Categories

① Furniture and items with the longest side measuring 150 cm or more, such as appliances, aquariums, picture frames, training equipment, fitness equipment, and lighting fixtures
※Two bulky waste disposal tickets are required.

② Electronic organs, organs, stereo systems (excluding mini component systems), washstands, kitchen sinks, bunk beds (including ladders), massage chairs, treadle sewing machines, dismantled storage sheds, and spring mattresses
※Two bulky waste disposal tickets are required.

③ Items not included in categories ① or ②
※One bulky waste disposal tickets is required.

① Items with a longest side of 150 cm or more / 2 tickets

Chest of drawers, sofa, bed (including disassembled items)

② Regardless of the length of the longest side / 2 tickets

Electone (electronic organ), Massage chair, Bed mattress (spring mattress)
※Springs only:
Remove the outer cover and dispose of it as burnable waste.

③ Items other than those listed above (① and ②) / 1 tickets

Stove • Fan heater, remove batteries and kerosene
Bicycle • Electric bicycle, remove the battery
Carpet, cut into four pieces (if it fits in a bag, dispose of it as burnable waste)
Futon, tie crosswise (1 item per futon)
Gas stove, remove batteries

Separate collection of hazardous waste

Types of hazardous waste:

- Flammable cassette cylinders, spray cans, aerosol cans, disposable lighters, etc.
- How to put it out: Be sure to use up the contents and put them in a transparent or translucent bag and tie them to the designated garbage bag for garbage that will not be burned.
- If you do not have a transparent or translucent bag, or if you only want to dispose of only hazardous garbage, please put only hazardous garbage in the designated garbage bag for non-burnable garbage.

 Fires have broken out in collection vehicles and processing facilities due to hazardous waste, so we ask for your cooperation in separating it.

Separate collection of fluorescent lamps

Some fluorescent lamps used in ordinary households contain mercury. For non-combustible garbage, put only the fluorescent light in the designated bag and turn it off so as not to damage it.

Separate Collection of Lithium-Ion Batteries and Similar Items

Lithium-ion batteries and similar items from households may cause fires if mixed with burnable or non-burnable waste. This can lead to fires and suspension of garbage collection vehicles or waste processing facilities.

How to Dispose
If lithium-ion batteries are swollen or deteriorated, please cover the terminals with insulating tape and bring them directly to the Residents' Affairs Division counter.

※ The above items cannot be processed at the cleaning center. When disposing of it, please consult with the place of purchase or a specialist. If you cannot pick it up at a store, please contact the Resident's Life Division.

Business waste

Regardless of whether it is for profit or non-profit, garbage generated from business activities (business establishment, shops, hospitals, etc.) must be properly disposed of at the responsibility of the business operator, and cannot be used for the collection of household waste in the town. Please request (contract) the disposal of industrial waste from an industrial waste disposal business licensed company. In addition, general waste related to the business should be requested by a collection and transportation company approved by the town, or the business itself should be brought to the cleaning center. We ask for your cooperation in reducing garbage and promoting recycling.

Clothing Reuse

Accepted Items: All types of clothing (shirts, pants, jackets, coats, skirts, children's clothing, etc.)
※ Items Not Accepted: Dirty, torn, stained items, or items with excessive pilling, Underwear, socks, swimwear, Kimono, obi belts, Shoes, Uniforms, gym clothes, sports uniforms, Jewelry (precious stones)

Collection Locations: Town Hall Building (in front of the Environmental Sanitation Section, Residents' Affairs, Old Building) Health and Welfare Center (Hiji Town Community Childcare Support Center "HUG Kumi")

Important Notes:

- Items placed in the collection box cannot be returned.
- Items with personal or school names are not able to reuse, so please refrain from submitting them.
- Do not place dirty or wet items in the box.
- Please do not force items into the box, as this may damage the insertion slot.

Home Appliance Recycling

Washing machine • clothes dryer, Refrigerator • Freezer, CRT • LCD • Plasma television, Air conditioner

The above four home appliances are subject to the Home Appliance Recycling Law and cannot be disposal of as garbage or brought to a cleaning center. If you want to dispose of it, ask an electric shop to pick it up. At that time, "recycling fee" and "collection and transportation fee" is required.

Collection request destination

① Please ask "the store you purchased in the past" or "The store you replaced" to pick up item.
② Request a general waste collection and transportation permit company in the town that is a member of the home appliance recycling Ticket system (Yamashita Shoten Co., Ltd. Tel. 72-2727)
③ Request to SG Moving Co., Ltd. (Hiji town Cooperation Operator) (※ See the back side)

④ If it is difficult to pick up the garbage from the above, apply for the town's bulky garbage collection

Procedure:

- Pay the recycling fee at the post office and receive the "Home Appliances Recycling Ticket"
- Bring a "Home Appliances Recycling Ticket" and apply at the Residents' Affairs Division counter. A separate collection and transportation fee is required (2,200yen)

 ※ The collection and transportation fee varies depending on the client. Please ask for details.

Collective collection of recyclable waste

We are promoting group collection by voluntary groups such as children's associations and senior citizens' clubs. Please contact the Residents' Affairs Division.

Items to be collected:

- Newspaper, leaflets, magazines, books
- Confectionary boxes, Cardboard
- Milk carton (Wash and dry)
- 1.8L bottles (Colors only)
- 720ml bottles (Colors only)
- Beer bottles
- Aluminum cans
