

# Reiwa 8th year Hiji Town Garbage Collection Calender

From April 1st, 8th year of Reiwa To March 31st, 9th year of Reiwa

※Please be sure to read it.

- Please separate the garbage and put it out at the designated place by 8:30 am on the day of collection.
- Depending on the amount of garbage and traffic conditions, it may not be possible to collect it at the usual time. Please be sure to serve by the specified time. (Garbage disposed after collection cannot be handled.) In addition, if you cannot safely dispose of garbage on the morning of the collection day due to bad weather such as typhoons, heavy rain, or snowfall, please put it out on the next collection day as much as possible.
- Collection work will be closed from December 31, Reiwa8 to January 3, Reiwa 9.
- Burnable garbage is also collected on public holidays.
- There are places where the area is changed in some districts.
- If you want to put out more than 10 bags at one time, please contact us in advance.
- Please do not park on the street as it will interfere with collection.

**STEP1** Select the category of the product you want to appraise.

**STEP2** Enter product and customer information and request an appraisal.

**STEP3** Select the purchasing store from the assessment results you receive.

**STEP4** Environmental and wallet friendly disposal of discarded items is completed.

### Garbage reduction

- 80% of the raw garbage is water, Let's squeeze one last thing.
- When shopping, if you want to eat right away, let's Take it From the front
- In order not to waste food, use it up and eat it up.
- Deliver unnecessary ingredients to those who need them by using "food banks" and put it out as recyclable waste.
- Let's separate the paper waste in the garbage and put it out as recyclable waste.
- Actively use your own bag, your own bottle (water bottle) and your own cutlery (chopsticks, etc.).
- If you can still use it, consider reusing it.
- Think carefully and buy without waste.
- Let's actively use group collection, small household appliance recycling, and waste cooking oil recycling.

### Preparing for Large-Scale Disasters~How to Dispose of Disaster Waste~

**Disaster Waste**  
The town will promptly designate temporary storage sites for disaster waste. Disposing of waste where is not designated sites may obstruct emergency vehicles and can cause fires due to spontaneous combustion, as well as attract pests and create unpleasant odors. Please do not leave waste on roads or vacant lot without permission.

**What is Disaster Waste?**  
Disaster waste refers to debris and house hold items generated during a disaster.

**Notice**  
General waste must be disposed at regular waste collection services, not at disaster waste temporary storage sites.

**When Temporary Disaster Waste Storage Sites Are Opened**  
Depending on the type of disaster, waste separation methods and accepted items may different. If the waste are sorted improperly, it cause delays of collection service and traffic jams. Please cooperate with your neighbors and bring waste separated by item whenever possible. When a disaster happened, the town will provide detailed information about separation methods and disposal procedures. To help restore daily life as quickly as possible, please check official information from the town and dispose of waste properly according to the guidelines.

Based on the Small Home Appliance Recycling Law

**Unnecessary Please cooperate in the correct collection of the computer.**

[Rest assured that your date will be erased] Erased safely and reliably at a nationally certifies factory! We collect PCs that are no longer needed at home free of charge by courier service (shortest next day, desired date and time). Here's how to use it:

**For each collection including the computer itself. Collection fee for 1 box Free**

①Application Apply via the Internet, fax, or phone.

②Pack the collected items All you have to do is pack it in a cardboard box!

③Collected by Sagawa Express Sagawa Express will visit you for collection at the desired date and time.

- Free collection and recycling fees for one box including a computer.
- Even if is old or broken, it can be recovered with "any computer".
- Along with the computer, peripherals and other small appliances are also collected.
